Att which said next Court to witt the Sixteenth Day of August and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six came again as well the affd Lewis Gale his Lordship's attorney who as well <sup>as</sup> the affd Mary Aick in Custody as affd, and because the Jus-  
tices <sup>here</sup> ~~for~~ their Judgmt. of and upon the premises and verdict affd to render, as yett  
will advise, day thereof is given as well to his said Lordship's attorney affd who as  
well <sup>as</sup> the affd Mary Aick in Custody as affd to hear thereof their <sup>Judgmt</sup> until next Court

Att which said next Court to witt the fifteenth Day of November and Dowd One thou-  
said seven hundred and twenty six, came again as well the affd Lewis Gale his  
Lordship's attorney who as well <sup>as</sup> the affd Mary Aick in Custody affd and where  
upon all and singular the premises by the Court here, being seen and mature deliberati-  
on had - Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that the affd Mary Aick  
be whipt with ~~twenty~~ twenty lashes, at the publick whipping Post on the Bare Bank well  
Laid on until the blood appear and that she stand in the pillowry a quarter of an  
hour, and that she be taken <sup>to</sup>. And thereupon as to the Corporal Punishment affd -  
Command is given to the Sher. of Somerset County, that he do thereof Immediate Execution -  
according to the Judgmt. affd rendered by whipping the affd Mary Aick with twenty lashes  
on the Bare Bank well said on until the blood appear and by sitting her in the  
pillowry a quarter of an hour; afterwards in the same Court the said Sher. returns  
that he hath done the Execution of the Judgmt. affd as to the Corporal punishment affd  
he was commanded - whereupon the affd Mary Aick is ordered <sup>by the Court</sup> to give Security for the paymt  
of the Several Officers herefor, by Oath of the premises affd, but for want  
thereof she is committed into the Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County there to remain &  
the said Sher. present here in Court took Charge of the said Mary Aick according <sup>to</sup>

Ann Barton - I promise of that now is for the body of Somerset County upon their Oath -  
do present that Ann Barton late of Somerset County & Quiter the tenth day of March and  
Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five with force and Arms <sup>at</sup> the County  
affd within the Jurisdiction of this Court fifteen yards of Linen of the value of fifteen  
pounds of Tobacco each yard of the goods and Chattell of Asertoni Thomas Fletcher then &  
there being found then and there feloniously did take Steal and Carry away against the  
peace
