Coleman at the Publick whiping Post with five lashes on the bare back well said on untill the blood appear, & by sitting him in the Pillory a quarter of an hour, afterwards in the same Court the Sherd returns that he has done the Execution of the Indictment ad. as to the Corporall Punishment ad. he was Commanded - whereupon a certain Thomas M<sup>r</sup> Foster, and Joseph Chamber being present in Court made oath to the best of their knowledge that the said Wm. Allen ad. Ed. Coleman is a servant to a certain Sam. Gale Living in the parishes &c

Thereupon the said William Allen ad. Edward Coleman is committed into the custody of the Sherd. of Somerset County there to remain & the said Sherd. present <sup>here</sup> Court took charge of him accordingly & wherefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said John Benson pay unto the said Thomas Seal one of the party's deprived four fold of the value of the Boat ad. amounting in the whole to two hundred pounds of t<sup>l</sup> also that he pay unto the said Francis Allen another of the party's deprived four fold of the value of the goods mentioned & said from him to be stolen, amounting in the whole to four hundred & forty pounds of t<sup>l</sup>. as also that he pay unto the said John Green, another of the party's deprived, four fold of the value of the goods mentioned in the Indictment from him to be stolen, amounting in the whole to two hundred & thirty pounds of t<sup>l</sup>. Likewise that he pay unto the said Elizabeth Whitmore the other of the party's deprived four fold of the value of the goods mentioned in the Indictment from him to be stolen amounting in the whole to three hundred & forty four pounds of t<sup>l</sup> (the said Boat Goods & Chattels being by the Court valued according to Law as a<sup>d</sup>) & that the said John Benson be whipt with five lashes on the bare back well said on untill the blood appear, & that he stand in the Pillory a quarter of an hour, & that he be taken & thereupon as to the Corporall punishment ad. Command is given to the Sherd of Somerset County that he do <sup>the</sup> Immediate Execution according to the Indictment ad. Warrant by whiping the said John Benson at the Publick whiping with five lashes on the bare back well said on untill the blood appear, & by sitting him in the Pillory a quarter of an hour, afterwards in the same Court the Sherd returns that he has done the Execution of the Indictment ad. as to the Corporall Punishment ad. he was Commanded - Thereupon the said it is ordered by the Court that the said John Benson's security for the four pounds and fees ad. whereupon a certain Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Foster present
