

in Court in his proper person undertakes for the said John Persons for to pay the four pound  
 and the Severall Officers their fees due by Occasion of the premises upon the Indenture  
 and Wherefore is Considered by the Justice here that the said Mary Aitch pay-  
 unto the said Thomas Beal one of the party's Deprived four fold of the value of the Boat  
 amounting in the whole to two hundred  $\text{p}^{\text{t}}$  of  $\text{tob}^{\text{t}}$  also that he pay unto J. ~~Thomas~~ <sup>Thomas</sup> Allen  
 another of the party's deprived four fold of the value of the goods mentioned & said from  
 him to be Stolen, amounting in the whole to four hundred & forty pound of  $\text{tob}^{\text{t}}$  as also  
 that he pay unto J. said John Owen another of the party's deprived four fold of the value  
 of the goods mentioned in the Indenture from him to be Stolen, amounting in the whole to two  
 hundred & ninety six  $\text{p}^{\text{t}}$  of  $\text{tob}^{\text{t}}$  Likewise that he pay unto the said Gabriel Wiltmore  
 the Other of the party's deprived four fold of the value of the goods mentioned in the Indenture  
 from him to be Stolen amounting in the whole to three hundred & forty four  $\text{p}^{\text{t}}$  of  $\text{tob}^{\text{t}}$   
 (the said Boat goods & Chattells being by the Court valued according to Law as aforesaid) that the  
 said Mary Aitch be whipt with five lashes on the bare back well said on until the blood  
 appear, & that she stand in the Billowry a quarter of an hour, & that she be taken  
 and thereupon as to the Corporall Punishment a Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset  
 County that he do hereof Immediate Execution according to the Indenture aforesaid, by  
 whipping the said Mary Aitch at the Publick Whipping Post with five lashes well said on  
 until the blood appear, & by sitting her in the Billowry a quarter of an hour afterwards  
 in the same Court the Sheriff returns that he has done the Execution of the Indenture  
 as to the Corporall Punishment as he was commanded - Whereupon it is ordered by  
 the Court that the said Mary Aitch give Security for the paym<sup>t</sup> of the four pound and the fees aforesaid  
 but for want thereof Command is given to the Sher. of Somerset that he sell the said Mary  
 Aitch to the biggest bidder not exceeding seven years to reimburse the four pound and fees  
 aforesaid due by Occasion of the premises - thereupon the said Mary Aitch pursuant  
 to the said Command is sold by the Sher. to a certain James Bowcher for seven years  
 to commence from this term, for the sum of two thousand and ten pounds of  $\text{tob}^{\text{t}}$  for  
 the use of the County &

Wherefore it is Considered by the Justice here  
 that the said Richard Gore pay unto the said Tho<sup>t</sup>. Beal one of the party's deprived  
 four fold of the value of the Boat aforesaid amounting in the whole to two hundred  $\text{p}^{\text{t}}$  of  
 $\text{tob}^{\text{t}}$  also that he pay unto the said Thomas Allen another of the party's deprived four fold  
 of the value of the goods mentioned & said from him to be Stolen amounting in the whole to
