

Thomas Bannister. } Thomas Bannister and Anthony West both of Somerset County being bound by Recognizance for their appearance this Court to answer his Lordship concerning all such matters and things as shall be objected against them on his said Lordship's behalf &c. Whereupon the said Thomas Bannister and Anthony West in their own proper persons appears and pray that their appearance may be recorded ~~for~~ and they discharged from the same Recognizance, to save them and their bail &c.

Thereupon the said Thomas Bannister and Anthony West's appearances were recorded, and they and their bail discharged as aforesaid is said.

But forasmuch as the said Thomas Bannister and Anthony West being indicted this Court for the feloniously Stealing forty pounds current money of Maryland being the proper money of a certain John Williams &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said Thomas Bannister and Anthony West give Recognizance in One hundred pounds Sterling each, with two Security each in fifty pounds Sterling each for their appearance at Next March Court to be hold for Somerset County at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of the same month aforesaid to answer &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Bannister, together with Andrew Thompson and John Givens of Somerset County Clerks his Security are present in Court before his said Lordship's Justice of the same Court ^{then} Judicially sitting, and acknowledged themselves indebted to his said Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary of this province that is to say the said Thomas Bannister in the Sum of One hundred pounds Sterling and the said Andrew Thompson and John Givens Separately in the Sum of fifty pounds Sterling good and lawfull money of England of their goods and Chattels Lands and Tenement, severately to be made and levied, to the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors. In case the said Thomas Bannister shall not make his personal appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next, to answer unto his said Lordship concerning his feloniously Stealing forty pounds current money, being the proper money of the said John Williams, whereof the said Thomas Bannister stands indicted, and to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereon, and not to depart the same Court without License thereof otherwise to be void &c.

Likewise the said Anthony West together with the said Andrew Thompson and Randal West of said County of Somerset Clerks his Security ^{all} present herein Court before his said Lordship's Justice of the same Court
