Then judicially Siting acknowledged themselves Indebted to his said Lordship the right Honourable Richard
proprietor of this Province that is to say the afo^r Anthony West in the sum of one hundred pounds sterl-
and the afo^r Andrew Thompson & Randall West severally in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling good &
Lawfull money of England of their goods & chattels Lands & tenements severally to be made delivered to -
the use of his said Lordship the said proprietor himself & executors - In case he said Anthony West
shall make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to -
be held at Bridg^r Beck the third Tuesday of march then next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning
his feloniously Stealing forty pounds curr^r money being the proper money of the afo^r John Williams
whereof the said Anthony West stands Indebted and to stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereon
and not to depart the same Court without leave thereof otherwise to be bound &

John Williams, William West, and William Croser ~~are~~ off Somerset County Clerks
being bound by Recognizance for their appearance this Court to give Evidence on behalfe of
his said Lordship against a certain Thomas Bannister and Anthony West, concern^r in their felo-
niously Stealing forty pounds Current money being the proper money of the said John Willi-
ams & appeared herein Court according to the tenor of their said Recognizance and pray that
their appearance may be recorded and they discharged from the same Recognizance, there-
upon the appearance of the afo^r John Williams, William West and William Croser were recorded
and they accordingly discharged - Whereupon it is further Ordered by the Court that the
said John Williams, William Croser, ~~and~~ William West, William Clerker John Silman, William
Furnis, Abel Wright Jun^r. all of the County afo^r be Ordered to give Recognition in the summe
of Eighty pounds Sterling & for their appearance at March Court next to be held for the County
afo^r at Bridg^r Beck the third Tuesday of the same month (and that the afo^r William West give
Security for his appearance) to give Evidence against the afo^r Thomas Bannister and Anthony
West afo^r - Whereupon the afo^r John Williams, William Croser, William Clerker
John Silman and William Furnis and Abel Wright Jun^r. all present in Court in their proper per-
sons acknowledged themselves to owe and be Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord proprie-
tary severally in Eighty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their goods and
chattels Lands and tenements severally to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship -

In case they do not make their personale appearance before the Justices of his said Lordships
County Court off Somerset to be held at Bridg^r Beck the third Tuesday of march then next to give
Evidence as they shall know against the afo^r Thomas Bannister and Anthony West afo^r and concern-
ing their feloniously Stealing of forty pounds curr^r: by the proper money of the said John -
Williams, and not to depart thence without the leave of that Court, otherwise to be bound &

Likewise the said William West, with Randall West his security both present in Court acknow-
ledged themselves to owe and be Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary, severally
in Eighty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their goods and chattels Lands &
tenements severally to be levied and made for the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary
