Whereupon the said Mary Horne being by the Sheriff set to the Bar, is Justly demanded how she would acquit herself of the premises as supposed upon her, saith that of the premises as so as as upon her supposed she is guilty thereof, and putteth her self in Mery of the said Lord Proprietor - but hath not wherewithal to pay her fine for the said as - Wherefore it is considered by the Justices that the said Mary Horne be whipt with Fifteen Lashes at the publick whipping Post with on the bare back where Laid on until the blood appear, and as to the corporal Punishment of Command is quicke the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do there of immediate Execution, by whipping the said Mary Horne at the Publick whipping Post on the bare back ^{very laid on} until the blood appear - and afterward the said Sheriff to returne in the same Court, that he hath done the Execution of the Judge as to the corporal Punishment as he was commanded & - Whereupon the said Mary Horne is Ordered to give Security for her answer unto the several Officers by reason of the premises - Whereupon after an William Stoughton undertakes for the said Mary Horne to pay the several Officers their fees due by means of the premises as &
