Thomas Billin } vizt Somerset Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Province of Maryland & Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sher. of Somerset County Greeting Whereas Jeffry Flowers of the Colony of Virginia lately in our County Court here to wit the 4th of the month of August Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & twenty five before us Worshipfull Samuel Hopkins & his associates then our Justices of Somerset County Court & by Consideration of the same Court at Dividing Creek Recovered against Tho: Billin late of Coventry Parish County aforesaid twenty three pence Nine Shillings & ten pence Curr: money of Maryland & Seven hundred & Ninety six pounds of Tob^o for his Damages which he sustained as well by Occasion of the Nonperformance of a certain assumption, to w^{ch} same Jeffry Flowers, by w^{ch} said Tho: Billin Made, as for his Costs Charges by him about his Suit in w^{ch} part expended, whereof he is convicted, as now appears of record by w^{ch} said Jeffry Flowers afterwards in w^{ch} Colony of Virginia and died, after whose Death Administration of all the singular w^{ch} goods & Chattels rights & Credits, which were of w^{ch} said Jeffry Flowers at w^{ch} time of his Death, to Peter Whiting of w^{ch} Colony of Virginia in Due forme of Law was committed, as by w^{ch} Letters of Administration and in our Court before our Justices brought fully appears as
