altho^o Judg^r be there upon tendered Never the less Execution of y^e Damages
& Costs ad^d as yett remaineth to be done to y^e retardation of y^e Execution of the
Administration ad^d whereupon w^asd Peter Whiting hath supplicated us for
a proper remedy in y^e part to him to be provided, & because we are Willing y^e
those things which in our Said County Court are right fully done so Should
Come to due Execution - We command you of by good & Lawfull meaus of your
Bailewick you Make Knowne unto w^asd Tho: Billin^r if he be & appear -
Before y^e Justices of our County Court of Somersett, to be held at Dividing Creek
the third tuesday of November Next to shew cause, if any thing for himself
he hath or knoweth to say, wherefore w^asd Peter Whiting his Execution
against him, of y^e Damages & Costs ad^d to have ought not according to y^e
Form & Effect of y^e Recovery ad^d, if unto him it shall seeme expedient
have you thene there y^e Names of thoes before whom you Make y^e same
Knowne, & this will witness Samuel Hopkins Gent. Chief Justice of our
Said Court this 19th day of August in y^e Eleventh Year of our Dominion &
Anno Domini 1726 -

At which said third tuesday of Novem^r. to wit the fifteenth day of the same
month anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six being the day of
the Return of the Said writt Comell the Said Peter Whiting adud. of the ad^d
Jeffry flowers by his attorney ad^d and the Sher^r. of somersett County to whom the
foregoing writ was directed Likewise Comell and makes Return thereof to the
Court hereunder signed and made Knowne by me Francis Allen Sher^r -

Whereupon the ad^d Peter Whiting adud. as ad^d by his attorney ad^d gray, Execu-
tion against the ad^d Thomas Billin^r of the Damages and Costs ad^d, But the ad^d Thomas
Billin^r altho^o Solemly called Comell not but makes Default - Therefore it is considered
by the Justices here the fifteenth day of Novem^r Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred
and twenty six that the ad^d Peter Whiting adud. as ad^d have his Execution against the ad^d
Thomas Billin^r as well the sum off twenty three pounds Nine Shillings and ten pence curr-
money of Maryland and Seven hundred and Ninety Six pounds of his Damages and Costs
318 ad^d as also the sum off Three hundred & Eighteen ^{his} pounds off his Costs for his
Costs and Charges sustained by Reason of Delay of Execution of the Judgment ad^d &
