his Body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that the said
John Holder will do it for him. Thereupon the said Joseph Holder by George Darlitt his attorney
appear and Imparles tile next Court &

L.G. George Tull
Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should
call Griffen Thomas Stake Griffen Thomas Late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in
his bailie with and have he should safe keep so that he might have his Body before
the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday
day of November to answer unto the sum of ten pounds per cent upon his debt upon his afo^d day.

And the afo^d George Tull by Levin Hale his attorney proceeded against the afo^d Griffen Thomas in
the plea afo^d as followeth witness Somerset vs. Griffen Thomas Late of Somerset County -
Planter was attached to Answer unto George Tull of say 1000 of trespass upon his afo^d day
And whereupon of same George by Levin Hale his attorney complained that
whereas afo^d Griffen on tenth day of July anno Domini One thousand and seven hundred
and twenty four at Somerset County with the judgment of this Court was indebted to the
same George in a sum of ten pounds twelve Shillings & Eleven pence Current Money
of Maryland for divers Goods Wares & Merchandizes for work Before of time -
By afo^d Said George to afo^d Griffen at his Special Instance & request sold delivered
to him & performed & so thereof being indebted of same Griffen in consideration
thereof afterwards to wit afo^d same Daye year afo^d at County afo^d within afo^d day
upon himself assumed & to of same George then & there faithfully promisid by the
wherinafterwards he should be thereto requested he afo^d Griffen afo^d sum of ten
pounds twelve Shillings and Eleven pence Current money to the same George would well and
faithfully content and pay nevertheless the said Griffen his promise and afo^d assumption afo^d in
form afo^d made little Regarding and plotting and fraudulently intending the afo^d George in his
part basely and Subtilly to deceive and defraud he the afo^d sum of ten pounds twelve Shillings
and Eleven pence Current money or any part thereof to the same George (altho' often afterward
to wit the same day and year afo^d at the County afo^d within the Jurisdiction afo^d by the same George
the said Griffen was thereto requested) he hath not paid or the same for it any wise contented
