And the afo Griffin Thomas by George Dashed his attorney Cometh and Defendeth the force and Injury when &c. And it is said by the Court here to the afo attorney of the afo Griffin that for the same Griffin his Oyant, to the afo George in the plea afo answer - whereupon the same attorney of the afo Griffin say that he is not Informed by the afo Griffin his Oyant of any answer to the afo Complaint in the plea afo to be given nor Nothing else there of say for which the same afo Remaneth against the afo Deft there of undefended

Wherefore the afo Deft his Damages by Quanon of his non performance of the promise and assumption afo against the afo Griffin ought to recover &c. whereupon the Justice here at the prayer of the afo George and by the consent of the afo Griffin according to act of asembly in such case made and provided, say that the afo Griffin did not assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the afo George against him above Complain'd &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here the fifteenth day of Novemb. and Dowd. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six that the afo George Tule take nothing by his writ and Declaration afo but be in mercy for his false Honour and that the afo Griffin Thomas have thereof without Day, also it is considered by the Justice that the afo Griffin Thomas recover Against the afo George Tule the Sum of two hundred and twenty Seven pounds of tobacco for his costs and Charges by him about his Suite in that part Expended to the same Griffin by the Court here of his spent according to the form of the Statute in such cases lately made and provided adjudged &c
