

Novemb. Court ---- 1726 - - - 195

That albertani Benjami Sharpe late of Somersett County was indebted unto the same Thomas in the sum of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco for which sum the same Thomas did file a suit and implead the same Benjamin for the said sum of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco on the eighth day of February anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five sic at annamere in Coventry parish within the Jurisdiction of this Court the said Richard did upon himself a sume and promise that the aforesaid twelve hundred pounds of tobacco he would well and truly content and pay when thereto requested, Nevertheless the same Richard his promise and engagement aforesaid informed made little regarding but intending him the same Thomas to defraud and deceive the aforesaid sum of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco unto the same Thomas tho' often thereto requested he hath not paid but the same to pay hath denied and still doth deny to the damage of the said Thomas of two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco and thereof he bringeth suit - *Richard Water plenger pro parte Richard Water*

And the said Richard Water by Leon Hale his attorney cogiteth and defendeth the force and injury whereof and praye leave to imparle hereto unto the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid plaintiff here also

At which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of June anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty five same action as were the aforesaid Thomas Bonner et al the aforesaid Richard Water by their attorney and the said Richard by his said attorney pray further leave to imparle hereto unto the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid party also

At which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of August anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five same action as were the aforesaid Thomas, et al the aforesaid Richard by their attorney and thereupon the said Richard by his said attorney, et al before Defendant the force and injury whereof And praye Judgment of the declaration and because he sayes that the declaration aforesaid the matter in the same contained are not sufficient in the Law the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Thomas against him the said Richard to have and maintain and that the said Richard to that declaration hath no need nor by virtue of law of the land is bound in anyway to answer and this he is ready to verify for wherefore for want of a sufficient Declaration without part the said Richard praye Judgment and that the declaration may be quashed &c And for leave of Denier in law upon the declaration aforesaid &c the said Richard to the Court here sheweth these causes following vizt
that
