Whereupon the afo John Bidel being called appears and thereupon the said John Bidel at the prayer of his plf's attorney and is adjudged to give speciall Baile to the action afo but for want whereof the said John Bidel is committed into the custody of the Sherif of Somersett County there to remain & the said Sherif present here in Court took charge of the said John Bidel accordingly thereupon day is given to the afo John Bidel in custody as afo until next Court, and the same day is given unto the afo Eliz. here also - At which said Next Court to wit the sixteenth day of August and. Dom One thousand and seven hundred and twenty six yea, againe the said Ephraim Willson by his attorney afo and thereupon the said Ephraim by his said attorney declared against the said John Bidel in the plea afo as followeth vid.

Somersett County p. John Bidels late of Somersett County Gent was attacted to answer unto Ephraim Willson of a plea of trespass upon the case &c
And whereupon the same Ephraim by Lewis Hale his attorney complaineth that whereas, the afo John the eighteenth day of April and Dom One thousand and seven hundred and twenty six at Somersett County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the same Ephraim in the sum off four pounds sixteen Shillings and nine pence Current money as by aco^d here with in Court produced may appear and so thereoff being indebted the said John in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day and year afo at the County afo within the afo Jurisdiction upon himself assumed and to the same Ephraim Then and there faithfully promised that he when afterward, he should be thereto requested to pay the sum off four pounds, Sixteen Shillings and Nine pence Cur^d. money to the same Ephraim would well and faithfully content and pay. Nevertheless the said John his promise and assumption afo in form afo made little regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending the afo Ephraim in that part to defraud and deceive him the afo
