Whereupon the said Honour Norgate being set to the barre by the Sherif. and the present m^t. being Read, pleads guilty, and puts herself in Mercy of the Lord proprietary, and pray, that she may be admitted to make fine to the said Lord proprietary for the fact a^d — Wherefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said Honour Norgate be fined to the Lord proprietary (to be appropriated toward the defraying of the County Charge) the Sum of thirty Shillings Court money for the fact a^d. Whereupon the Justice at the Prayer of Philip Covington Master of the said Honour Norgate doo adjudge that the said Honour Norgate should serve her said Master ten full months to Commence at the End of the said Honour Norgate's Service, the said ten Month Service being adjudged to be full Satisfaction, for damages trouble and Loss of time the said Philip Covington had at the time of her Child bearing &
