Wherefore it is Ordered by the Court that the said Ester Deneckis be whipt with fifteen lashes on the Bear Backe were laid on until the blood appear, and as to the forgorous punishment aff command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do thareof immediate Execution by whiping the affd Ester Deneckis at the publick whipping post with fifteen lashes on the bear backe were laid on until the blood appear, and afterwards in the same Court the said Sheriff statutis that he has done the Execution of the judgment affd as to the forgorous punishment aff he was concurred in —

Whereupon the said Ester Deneckis is Ordered to give a security for all the Officers fees due by reason of the premises affd. Whereupon aforlame Abrahams Ford Comell into Court and Confessest Judge unto the severall Officers fees due by reason of the premises, Likewise he said Abrahams Ford undertakes for the said Ester Deneckis interponnes thereto to be bound on his goods or chattels said instruments for the use of the said Lord proprietary. In farr the said Ester Deneckis doe not make her personal appearance before the Justices of the County Court to be held at Dividing feare the third Tuesday of August next to give evidence against aforlame Richard Belacery &c —
