Never the less the said Catherine her promises and Description Afore  
in form Afored. Made little regarding but Plotting and fraudulently  
Intending the Afored. John in that part to Defraud & Deceive  
She the Afored. Sum of Fifty five Bushells of Indian Corn or any  
part thereof to the same John hath not paid or him for it in  
any wise Contented Although the s: Catherine Afterwards to wit  
the same Day and Year Afored: at the County Afored. & within the  
Afored Ind was thereto by the same John requested but the s:  
Catherine the same heltherto to Doe hath Altogether refused  
and still doth refuse to the Damage of the same John of one  
hundred and ten Bushells of the Cornes and thereof he brings
