 next to answer unto Aaron Jui of Exeter of the part upon the case & that there of he
 should not fail &c - And whereupon the same Aaron by Lewis Gale his atty. Conclaves
 that whereas the said Aaron by Jui Gale his atty. Conclaves
 at Somerset County within the Jur. of this Court was indebted to the same Aaron Jui in the sum
 of seventeen pounds twelve shillings & four pence current money of as by ind. herewith in Court
 produced may appear and so there of being indebted the same Aaron in Consideration there of aft-
 erwards to witt the same day and year as at the County as within the Jur. as upon himselfe
 assumed and to the same Aaron then and there faithfully promised that he when afterwards
 he should be there to requested he the said Sum of seventeen p. twelve shillings & four pence
 current money to the same Aaron would well & faithfully content and pay never the less of same after
 his promise and assumption as in forme as made Vittle regarding and blotting & fraudul-
 ently Intending the same Aaron in that part craftily & sully to defraud and Deceive he the
 said Sum of seventeen p. twelve shillings and four pence current money or any part thereof to the
 same Aaron hath not paid altho the said Aaron after afterwards to witt the same day and year as at the
 County as within the Jur. was therunto by the same Aaron requested by the said Aaron
 the same hath not doe hath altogether refused and still doth refuse where by the said
 Aaron says he is worse and hath damage to the value of forty pounds current money and thereof
 he brings this Suite &c
