At which said next Court to witt the fifteenth day of Novem<sup>r</sup>. to wit the anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six Cometh againe as well the afo<sup>d</sup> John Tule a<sup>s</sup> the afo<sup>d</sup> Thomas Fletcher by their attorneys afo<sup>d</sup> and Whereupon the said Thomas Fletcher by his said attorney says that he cannot gaineay the action afo<sup>d</sup> of the afo<sup>d</sup> John son afo<sup>d</sup> against him brought nor can he say but that the same John ought to recover his damage by reason of the greate loss afo<sup>d</sup> to three pound Seven Shillings & Silver money and costs of suite against him which the same afo<sup>d</sup> doth not gaineay —

Therefore it is considered by the Justis here the fifteenth day of Novem<sup>r</sup>  
Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six afo<sup>d</sup> that the afo<sup>d</sup> John Tule recover ag<sup>t</sup> the afo<sup>d</sup> Thomas Fletcher three pound Seven Shillings & Silver money his damage afo<sup>d</sup> in forme of Confesse<sup>d</sup> as also Two hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco for his costs  
and charges by him about his Suite in that part Regarded to the same John by the Court here after afo<sup>d</sup> a sum ad judg<sup>d</sup> and the afo<sup>d</sup> Deft in Mercy &c —

And Whereupon the said Jos: by Favin Gale his attorney Complains that  
whereas the afo<sup>d</sup> John Anderson the tenth day of June anno Domini one thousand Seven  
hundred and twenty Six at Somersott County within the Jur<sup>r</sup> of this Court was Judicled unto the  
same Joseph in the sum of four hundred and Seventy seven pounds of tobacco as by Law here  
within Court produced may appear & to there of being Judicled the same Joseph in Considera  
tion thereof afterwards to witt the same day & year afo<sup>d</sup> at the County afo<sup>d</sup> within the Jur<sup>r</sup> afo<sup>d</sup> upon  
himself affirmed & to the same Joseph he and there faithfully promised that he when after  
wards he should be thereto requested he the afo<sup>d</sup> sum of four hundred and Seventy seven pds of  
tobacco to the same Jos: would well and faithfully Content and pay nevertheless the same John  
his promising affirming afo<sup>d</sup> in forme afo<sup>d</sup> made little regarding & plotting & fraudulently  
Inducing the same Joseph in that part Craftily and Subtilty to defraud & deceive the afo<sup>d</sup>  
sum of four hundred & Seventy Seven pounds of tobacco or any part thereof to the same Joseph  
he hath not paid altho' the said John afterwards to witt the same day & year afo<sup>d</sup> at the County afo<sup>d</sup>  
within the afo<sup>d</sup> Jur<sup>r</sup> was therewith by the same Joseph Required but the said John the  
same Citherto to doe hath altogether Refused & will doth refuse to there by the said  
(Joseph)
