are defrauded and have damage to the value of one thousand pounds of tobacco and thereof they bring suit
and offers here in Court the writing obligatorie of which the debt and debt certifie of the same Wm^m Soultrey-
Esther and Hammal Whittington brings herein the same Court as well the Letters testamentary of the
afo^d Stevens White by which it manifestly appears to the Court here that the afo^d Wm^m Whittington Esq^r
was t^e of the testament of the afo^d Stevens White and thereof to have admt as the Letters testamentary

Whereupon the afo^d Thomas Brown being called & appears and whereupon the said Tho.
Brown at the prayer of the afo^d attorney afo^d the said Thomas Brown is adjudged to give special
bail to the action afo^d — Whereupon a certain Thomas Barston of Somersett County pleader pro-
sent here in Court undertakes for the said Thomas Brown that if in case the afo^d Wm^m Soultrey-
Esther and Hammal Whittington's place recover judgment in the plea afo^d against the said Thomas Brown or that
the said Thomas Brown shall be therewith levied that then he the said Thomas Brown shall pay the
condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his Body to the custody of the Sher^t. of Somersett
County in Satisfaction whereof or that he the said Thomas Barston will do it for him —

And whereupon the said Thomas Brown in his own proper person cometh and defendeth
the same and injury wher^t and saith that he cannot giv^e any the action afo^d of the afo^d Wm^m
Soultrey, Esther and Hammal Esq^r afo^d, nor but that he defrauded from them the afo^d Nine thou-
sand two hundred and fifty three pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the same Wm^m Soultrey,
Esther and Hammal Whittington above against him declared &c —

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the fifteenth day of November and
Dom^m One thousand seven hundred and twenty six that the afo^d William Soultrey Esther and Ham-
mal Whittington's Esq^r afo^d Recover against the afo^d Thomas Brown Nine thousand two hundred
and fifty two pounds of tobacco his debt afo^d as also Three hundred and Sixty
and threepence upon which they surpasse by reason of a defrauding divers debts as
pounds of tobacco for rent and charges by them about their suit in that part Expended to the same
off^t by the Court here of their afo^d adjudged and the afo^d debt in misery &c
