On the back side of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus Endorsed viz

His Lordship

Whereas a certain Eliz^e. Townsend being Count of Barony of Joseph Bound^r a bastard child, and made Oath that a certain Joseph Bound^r is the beget-

ter of the same Child &c. Thereupon Command was given to the Sher^r. of Somerset County that he should take the said Joseph Bound^r if he should be found in his County work and punis^r should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of His Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Widning Creek the third Tuesday of August next to answer unto his said Lordship concerning his begetting of the Bastard Child afo^r, of the afo^r Eliz^e. Townsend, and that thereof he should not fail &c.

At which said third Tuesday of August to wit the Sixteenth day of the same month and anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six came the Sher^r. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed and makes return whereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following viz.

Legi Corpus proffran. Allen Sher^r

Whereupon the said Sher^r. altho' solemnly called brings not in the Body of the afo^r Joseph Bound^r according to the return of the writ afo^r, whereupon the said Sher^r. Crays further true hereunder the next Court to be held for the County afo^r, to bring in the said Joseph Bound^r to answer unto his said Lordship, which is granted &c.

At which said next Court to wit the fifteenth day of November anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six comes the said Joseph Bound^r by George Darsell his attorney and says that of the sum of one hundred and twenty six pounds he is quitt thereof and crays that he may be admitted to make fine to the said Lord Proprietary for the afo^r and of the same of himself himself in every of the said Lord Proprietary land

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the said Joseph Bound^r be taken to satisfy his fine by auction of the premises afo^r, and the fine of the same Joseph Bound^r is by the Justices taxed to thirty Shillings, to be appropriated toward the defraying of the County Charge afo^r. whereupon the said Joseph Bound^r is ordered by the Court to give Security for the fine afo^r, and alfor^r what awwed due to the several Officers by Occasion of the premises afo^r whereupon the said George Darsell present herein Court undertakes for the said Joseph Bound^r to pay the fine afo^r and the several Officers for due by means of the premises afo^r.
