Whereas a certain John Davis of Sussex County in the ~~County~~ Territory of Pennsylvania Planter, being bound by Recognizance in twenty pounds Sterl<sup>d</sup> Lawfull Money of England to be Levied of his goods and Chattels, Lands and tenements for the use of the right honorable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland his heirs and Successors - In case he did not appear to give Evidence against a certain Edmond Huggins &c. Recover against the said John Davis the said twenty pounds Sterl<sup>d</sup>. by him to be Levied upon his goods and Chattels, Lands and tenements for the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors &c
