Ordered by the Court that Israhel Bredale pay unto Joseph Miller and George Taylor Ninety p^{ts} of tobe each for their attendance two days each as Evidence on behalfe of the Lord proprietary against him they having made oath to the Same &

Ordered by the Court that Anthony West and Thomas Barnister pay unto John Phillips one hundred and Eighty pounds of tobe being due unto him, for his, and wife, attendance three days each as Evidence on behalfe of the Lord proprietary ag: them the said Anthony and Thomas, they having made oath to the Same &

Ordered by the Court that Isaac Jaggson pay unto Thomas Darwell Junr. Sixty pounds of tobe for his attendance two days as Evidence on behalfe of ^{the said} Isaac Jaggson ag: John Barber he having made oath to the Same &

Ordered by the Court that Isaac Jaggson pay unto Abraham Smith one hundred and twenty pounds of tobe being due unto him for his attendance four day as Evidence on behalfe of the said Isaac Jaggson against John Barber he having made oath to the Same &
