and injury whereto. And with that he cannot gainsay but that he did growl & swear

and the same declaration in all the words before Eggersby Justice Clerk —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the fifteenth day of Novem.
and anno one thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Six that the aforesaid Joseph M'Gester
recover against the aforesaid John Newbold Eight hundred & eighteen pounds of tbo. his damages
as above in the declaration aff'd & gaufed as also two hundred and forty eight
pounds of tbo. for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appertaining to
the same Joseph by the Court here of his aforesaid adjudged and the aforesaid debt in every

Andrew Scott Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take
Giles Barlow — Giles Barlow late of Somerset County Glazier of the said defendant in
his bailey wch and him should safe keep so that he might have his body
before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater
the third Tuesday of Novem. then next to satisfie unto a certain Andrew Scott of two
thousand and Sixty good Barrett Staves and Eight hundred and twenty five pounds of
tbo. which were adjudged unto the said Andrew Scott by the County Court of Somerset for his
damages which he sustained as well by reason of the non performance of a certain promise
and assumption off by the same Giles Barlow to the aforesaid Andrew Scott lately made after
his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part Expendit &c and that there of he should
not sue for — At which said third Tuesday of Novem. — To wit the fifteenth day
of the same month and anno One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Six fourth the aforesaid
Andrew Scott by Lewis Gale his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing
writ was directed and made return hereof endorsed by C. Rogers of Green Allerton.

And whereupon the said Giles Barlow present here in Court and being by the Recd. Set to
the bar, is hereupon at the prayer of the aforesaid attorney committed into the custody of the
Sheriff of Somerset County until the aforesaid Andrew Scott of his damages and costs aforesaid be
hereof fully satisfied — the said Sheriff having had in Court took charge of the said Giles
Barlow accordingly &c —
