

Nov Court -- 1726 -- 212.
Wm. Evans by Lewis Gale his attorney sued out his Lordships writ of fier facias
against the debt the tenor whereof followeth in this word, viz -

Be it Tull & C^r to the absolute Lord and Proprietary of the province of Maryland &c. To the Sheriff of
Somerset County greeting we command you that of the goods and chattels which were of Charles Evans
late of Somerset County deceased in the hands of Benj. Fox late of the County, and Elmer & Mary his wife executors of the
testament and last will of the afoe Charles Evans being in your hands that you make due hundred & Sixty Nine
pence and one pound of tbs. and Seven hundred & Sixty two pds. of tbs. which were adjudged unto Wm. Evans
by our Justices at Dividing Creek in Somersett County afoe for his damages or whiche he sustained as well by reason
of the non performance of a certain agreement to the same Wm. Evans, by the afoe Charles Evans in his life
time made after his last will and Testament by him about his estate in that part of his estate of the afoe Benjamin
Fox and Mary his wife are levied, if the afoe Benj. Fox and Mary his wife have so much good and chattels
which were the afoe Charles Evans at the time of his death in their hands remaining to be administered, & if
they have not so much in their hands to be administered that then you have the damages and costs afoe of
the proper good and chattels of the afoe Benjamin Fox and Mary his wife, and that you have the same
before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somersett County afoe the third Tuesday
of November next to satisfy unto the afoe William Evans his damages and costs afoe and leave you then
and there this 1st M^r 1726.

At which said third Tuesday of November to with the fifteenth day of the same month and year
One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six pms. being the day of the return of the said writ Comell
the afoe William Evans and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed
likewise Comell and marks to him hereof endorsed in these wds. I bid you affai. Fran. Oberfield
