Benj Full vs Against the debt the tenor whereof followeth in these words, viz -  
Charles, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the province of Maryland &c. To the Sheriff of

Somerset County by writing we Comand you that of the goods and Chattels which were of Charles Eunis  
Sale of Somerset County out in the hands of Benj Full late of the County of Glouster & Mary his wife &c of the  
testament and last will of the said Charles Eunis being in your hands, that you made nine hundred & sixty nine  
pounds and one pound of 1000 and seven hundred & thirty two p<sup>d</sup> of 1000, which were adjudged unto Wm Eunis  
by our Justices at Dividing Creek in Somerset County &c for his damages which he sustained as well by reason  
of the non performance of a certain assumption to the same Wm Eunis, by the said Charles Eunis in his life  
time made as for his last and Charges by him about his debts in that part by paid whereof the said Benjamin  
Full and Mary his wife are Comitt, if the said Benj Full and Mary his wife have so much goods and Chattels  
which were the said Charles Eunis at the time of his death in their hands remaining be administered, & if  
they have not so much within hands to be administered that then you have the damages and Costs &c of  
the proper goods and Chattels of the said Benjamin Full and Mary his wife, and that you have the same  
before the Justices of our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek in Somerset County &c the third Tuesday  
of Novemb next to satisfy unto the said William Eunis his damages and Costs &c and said have you there  
and there this Writ Witness &c.

At the which said third Tuesday of Novemb to with the fifteenth day of the same month and Dowd  
One thousand seven hundred and twenty six Com being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh  
the said William Eunis and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed &c  
Likewise Cometh and maketh return hereof endorsed in these words, viz: *ffrai: ffrai: ffrai: Allen*
