Afterwards here in Court his Lordships Commission of the Peace being produced with aeditions
Bolsteratum, whereupon Proclamation being made in usual form, command is given that all persons
then present were to keep silence and hear the same Commission Openly read as followeth
Sir - Maryland to Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and
Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. Sam'l Hopkins, Wm: Blamer, John Jones, Wm: Farritt, John Smith
Baltimore hundred Wm: Stoughton, John Caldwell, John M'Gester, John Hardy, James Dashwood
John Scott and Robert King of Somerset County your greeting Know ye that we have assinged
you and every of you jointly & severally our Justices to keep our Peace with
in our County of Somerset to make and cause to be kept all Ordinances &
Statutes as well of that part of the Kingdom of Great Britain called Eng-
land as of this our Province of Maryland for the good & conservation of
Peace and Quiet Rule & Government of our people within our said County
in all & every of Articles therein Regest according to the force & effect
of the same & to Chastize & Punish all or any Person or Persons offend-
ing against any of said Ordinances or Statutes according to the direction
thereof and to call before you or any of you all those who in our County
shall threaten to do any Bodily harm to any of our good people or to
burn their Houses or otherwise break our peace & misbehave them-
selves to find sufficient Security of the peace & good Behaviour to us
our good people & if they shall refuse to find such Security, if then
you cause them to be committed into safe Custody until they shall
find the same also we have assinged you every three or more of you of
whome we will you w: Samuell Hopkins, W: Blamer, Jn: Jones
W: Farritt and Jn: Smith or one of you always to be one our Justices
to Enquire by of Oathes of good & Lawfull men of our County and by whome
the truth of the premises may be better known of all & all manner of felonies

Regratings forestatings & Detortions what so ever & of all & other Mis-
feasances and offences whatsoever of which Justices of our peace lawfully
may
