Whereas Mad^m. Mary Hampton having turned the Road that lead from towards
W^m Handy, to the Court house, for the convenience of making a pasture, and bound
a new Road, Whereupon a certain Robert King of Somerset County Gent. prays the
Court that the a^d New Road bound by the a^d Mary Hampton may be ordered to be
the County Road, and that the Old Road may be stopped &c

And for as much as Several of the Justice had viewed the a^d New Road.
thought it very good and that the same was like so to remain &c

Thereupon It is ordered by the Court that the a^d New Road
be deemed and adjudged the County Road instead of the Old One, the making it good and
passable if ever it should chance to be bad &c

Solomon Tule appointed Overseer to clear a bridle Path from Back Creek wading
place up to three ~~places~~ firdle trees standing on a ledge called half moon ridge

U^psher King appointed Overseer in the stead of Stephen Odier and Lidewick
to clear a^d bridle path from where Solomon Tule leaves off and End at the former
Limits being about three quarters of a mile from Abranch called Stephens branch

Lazarus Maddox and Thomas Newbold to clear a bridle path, to begin where U^psher
King leaves off, and to clear into the road that lead to the Court house &c

Man negro Gile of Thomas Bell is adjudged by the Court to be of the age of four
teen years &c

Tommy negro Boy of Stephen Warder is adjudged to be the age of
fourteen years &c

David Brown an Orphan came into Court, and prays that for
as much as he is of full age for the Breving his guardian he may be admitted to show
a certain Mary Brown of Somerset County Gentlewoman his Guardian, which is granted &c

Whereupon the said David Brown makes show of the said David Brown as his
guardian
