Current money and six hundred p<sup>rs</sup>. tob<sup>o</sup>: & when you have the same attached  
or any part thereof of the same in your custody safe keep so if you have  
the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing-  
Creek in Somerset County and the third Tuesday of March next then & there  
to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of Aaron Linn  
unless the said Apher Sherge by himselfe or his atty. shall app-  
ear and answer unto the said Aaron Linn in a plea of Trespass upon the Case  
& according to Law and y<sup>t</sup>. by good & Lawfull men of your Bailiwick  
you make known unto y<sup>r</sup> person or persons in whose hands you make & same  
attached: if he she or they be & appear before y<sup>r</sup> Justices of our said County  
Court to be held as afo<sup>r</sup> to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the  
same goods or Chattles rights or Credits ~~be~~ attached in his her or their hands  
ought not to be condemned & Execution thereof had & made according to y<sup>r</sup> former  
of y<sup>r</sup> act of assembly in such case made & provided if to him her or them it  
shall seem mete & how you shall execute this Writt if you make known  
unto our S<sup>d</sup>. Justices at y<sup>e</sup> same day & place afo<sup>r</sup> & have you then & there this  
Writt Witten &

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the twenty first day of the same month and  
Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Six being the day of the return of the said Writt  
Cometh the afo<sup>r</sup> Aaron Linn by his attorney afo<sup>r</sup> and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the  
foregoing writ was directed & he w<sup>th</sup> some and maketh Return thereof to the Court here Enor:  
sed in these words viz - By virtue of the within writ to me directed to the I have attached  
to the value of Twenty pounds Curr. money and six hundred pounds of tobacco in the hands of  
Isaac Handy and have summoned him as garnishee to appear & to shew Cause & as by the  
within writ I am commanded before John Doe and Richard Roe good and Lawfull men of my  
bailiwick so answers - Francis Allen Sher.

Whereupon the afo<sup>r</sup> Isaac Handy Garnishee as afo<sup>r</sup> by George Darnall his attorney  
Comer and saith that he cannot garnishee but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the afo<sup>r</sup> Apher  
Sherge to the value of Eighteen pounds Curr. money and six hundred pounds of tobacco, nor but that  
the said ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the said Aaron Linn as of the rights  
and Credits of the afo<sup>r</sup> Apher Sherge which the said Linn doth not garnishee

Whereupon the afo<sup>r</sup> Aaron Linn by his attorney afo<sup>r</sup> prays that the afo<sup>r</sup> Linn's so as  
afo<sup>r</sup> proposed by the afo<sup>r</sup> Isaac Handy as of the Rights and Credits of the said Apher Sherge  
may be condemned  
in the hands of the afo<sup>r</sup> Isaac Handy toward satisfying unto the said Aaron Linn his damages &  
Costs &

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the afo<sup>r</sup> Linn  
of Eighteen pounds Curr. money and six hundred pounds of tobacco so as afo<sup>r</sup> proposed be condemned in  
the hands of the afo<sup>r</sup> Isaac Handy as of the Rights and Credits of the afo<sup>r</sup> Apher Sherge toward
