Whereupon the said George Dashwell prays that upon giving Security according to act of assembly the said Sum of thirty Shillings so as aforesaid Confessed by the said William Miles, as of the Rights and Credits of the said John Hope may be condemned in the hands of the said William Miles towards Satisfying of ~~the~~ his damages and Costs &c. Whereupon Seven Gent of Somerset County Gent Present herein Court undertakes for the said George Dashwell according to act of assembly that in Case the said John Hope shall at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any Part of the said George Dashwell's Claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to have been made before the saying of this attachment that then the said George Dashwell shall make Restitution unto him the said John Hope of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said Seven Gent will do it for him

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the said Sum of thirty Shillings so as aforesaid Confessed be condemned in the hands of the said William Miles as of the Rights and Credits of the said John Hope towards Satisfying unto the said George Dashwell his damages and Costs &c. and that the said George Dashwell have thereof his Costs according to act of assembly &c.
