attorney comes and says that he can not garnishe but that he has of the Rights and Credits of the afo  
John Hope to the value of thirty Shillings, nor can he say but that the same ought to be condemned  
in his hands, for the use of the said George Dashott as of the Rights and Credits of the said John  
Hope which the said Clerk doth not garnishe.

Whereupon the said George Dashott prays that upon giving security according to act  
of assembly the afo sum of thirty Shillings so as afo Confeſed by the afo William Miles, as of the  
Rights and Credits of the afo John Hope may be condemned in the hands of the said William Miles,  
towards Satisfying off him his damage and costs &c. Whereupon Seven dayes of Somerset County  
Genl Present hereon Court undertake for the said George Dashott according to act of assembly that  
in case the said John Hope shall at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any  
part of the said George Dashott claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue  
before the saying of this attouch<sup>t</sup> that then the said George Dashott shall make Resolution unto him  
the said John Hope of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c or that he the  
said Lewis Hale will do it for him.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the afo sum of thirty Shillings,  
so as afo Confeſed be condemned in the hands of the afo William Miles as of the Rights and  
Credits of the afo John Hope towards Satisfying unto the said George Dashott his damage and  
costs &c and that the said George Dashott have there of his £<sup>4</sup> according to act of assembly &c.

Memorandum in the p<sup>t</sup> by George Dashott his attorney sued out his Recd<sup>r</sup> and  
writt of Surety against the debt the tenor whereof followeth in these wordz  
Bart. Somerset f. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietor of the province  
of Maryland and a notable Lord Baron of Baltimore etc. To y<sup>r</sup> Exell<sup>y</sup>  
of Somerset County Greeting Whereas James Caldwell lately in our County  
Court of Somerset here (to witt) on the seven teenth day of March anno domini One  
thousand Seven hundred and twenty four before the Worslyfull Samuel  
Hopkins Gent and his associates then Justices of our same Court (allduring  
the same) and by Consideration of the same Court recovered against a certaine John  
Denton late of Somerset County Gentleman eight hundred and forty five  
pounds of Job<sup>t</sup> for his damages which he sustained as well by occasion  
of the non performance of a certaine Promise to the same James by the afo  
John made as for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in part  
legended whereof he is Convict as by the records and Processe there of in the  
same Court before us remaining manifestly appeareth and altho. Judg<sup>d</sup>  
be there upon rendered Nevertheles<sup>s</sup> Execution of the Damages and Costs  
affo as yett remaineth to be done as by the Indination of the afo James we
