At which said ~~the~~ third tuesday of March to witt the twenty first  
day of the same Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and  
twenty Six Being the day of the return of the said Writt Cometh the afo  
James Caldwell by his atty afo and the Sher of Somerset County to whom  
the foregoing Writt was Directed likewise Cometh and maketh Return  
thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words Vizt  
Made known \_\_\_\_\_ Brau: Allen Sher \_\_\_\_\_

And the afo John Dewston afo. so to answer, being solemnly called Cometh not  
but makes default &c. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the afo  
James Caldwell have his Execution against the afo John Dewston as well for the Sum of  
Eight hundred and twenty five pounds of tob. his damages afo as also the Sum of  
two hundred and fifty pounds of tob. <sup>afo James by the same Court were adjudged and ought to pay of the</sup> ~~to the~~ damages <sup>for</sup> and Charges <sup>sustained by</sup> ~~by~~
