Whereupon the afo<sup>d</sup> William Twyfoot present here in Court in his proper person is at the prayer of the C<sup>t</sup> attorney afo<sup>d</sup> adjudged to give Specie, Baile to the C<sup>t</sup> of the sum afo<sup>d</sup> whereinon afo<sup>d</sup> John Hanger of Somerset County Blanter present here in Court undertaken for the said William Twyfoot that in case the said Joseph Maffester shall recover Judg<sup>m</sup>t in the pleas afo<sup>d</sup> against the afo<sup>d</sup> William Twyfoot or that the said William Twyfoot shall be herein Convit that then he the said William Twyfoot shall pay the Condemnation of the Court hereupon or tender his Body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction hereof or that he the said John Hanger will do it for him.

And the afo<sup>d</sup> William Twyfoot by George Darville his attorney concurring.
