

A Copy of the foregoing Declaration and Award were made and sent to be served on Isaac Wilson,  
with the writ in the plea aff'd —

At which said third Tuesday of March Nextto with the twenty first day of the  
same Month anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & twenty six Cometh of  
Jd: Joseph McCarter by his atty aff'd and the Sherif of Somerset County to whom of  
foregoing Writ was directed Likewise Cometh Elizabeth & Mary their daughters  
Court here endorsed in these words first — *Cogitatus debet & deliverd in time p-*  
*me Ibra: Allen Sherif*

Whereupon the aff'd Willm Brereton by Geo: Dashiel his atty comes & defen-  
deth the force & injury whereof he say, that he cannot deny but that he did affreid  
upon himselfe in manner & form as the aff'd Joseph above against him declared,  
nor but that he owes the aff'd Joseph seven hundred & forty four pounds of  
Tob: Part of the Debt aff'd sued for, which the said Court doth not giveth &<sup>20</sup>

There fore it is Considered by the Court here that the aff'd Joseph McCarter —  
Recover against the aff'd Willm Brereton as well the sum of Seven hundred &  
forty four pounds of Tob: his Damages aff'd in form aff' Confessed as also the  
Sum of two hundred & Seventy Nine pd: of Tob: for his Costs & Charges by  
him about his Suite in that part referred to the same Joseph by the Court  
here of his affent adjudged & aff'd Deft in Mercy &<sup>20</sup>

Committment was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take —  
Thomas Gordon late of Somerset County planter of he ~~should~~ <sup>be found in his</sup>   
Bailywick and sum should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the  
Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Doding Creek the third Tuesday of  
March next to answer unto Joseph McCarter of a debt of money upon the Case & d' and that  
hereof he Should not fail &<sup>20</sup> — And that Joseph McCarter by Lewis Hale his attorney declared  
against the aff'd Thomas in the plea aff'd as followeth &<sup>20</sup> — Somerset vs Thomas Gordon  
late of Somerset County planter was attacted to answer unto Joseph McCarter of a debt of money  
upon the Case &<sup>20</sup> —

And Whereupon the said Joseph by Lewis Hale his  
attorney Complaines that whereas the said Thomas the first day of November Anno Domini one thousand and  
seven hundred and twenty six at Somerset County and within the Jur. of this Court was Indebted —  
unto the said Jd: in one thousand five hundred and Seventy five pounds of Tob: as by Act: Parcunto  
assured may appear and being thereof Indebted the said Thomas in Consideration whereof  
the day and year at the place of upon himselfe did promise and to the said Jd: then and there did  
faithfully promise that he the said Tho: the said one thousand five hundred and Seventy five pd:  
of Tob: to the said Jd: when he should be thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and  
content and altho' the said Tho: one hundred pounds of Tob: part of the said Debt to the said  
Joseph he hath paid and satisfied yet as to the residue thereof being one thousand four  
hundred,
