Whereupon the afd Willm Breerton by Geo: Dashiell his atty comes & defends the force & Injury when he say, that he cannot deny but that he did assume upon himself in manner & form as the afd Joseph above against him Declared, nor but that he owes the afd Joseph Seven hundred & forty four pounds of Tob: Part of the Debt afd Sued for, which the said Cegi doth not gain say

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the afd Joseph McCarter Recover against the afd Willm Breerton as well the sum of Seven hundred & forty four pounds of Tob: his Damages afd in form afd Confessed as also the Sum of two hundred & seventy nine pd: of Tob: for his Costs & Charges by him about his Suite in that part Expended to the same Joseph by the Court here of his afd afd Deft in Mercy &c

24 The same } Command was given to the Sher of Somerset County that he should Take Thomas Gordon late of Somerset County planter if he <sup>should</sup> be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices of his Lord's high County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creeke the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Joseph McCarter of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c and that hereof he should not fail W - And the afd Joseph McCarter by Swin Gale his attorney declared against the afd Thomas in the plea afd as followeth vizt - Somerset s: Thomas Gordon late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Joseph McCarter of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c And Whereupon the said Joseph by Swin Gale his attorney brings in that whereas the said Thomas the first day of Novemb came down one thousand Seven hundred and twenty six at Somerset County afd within the Jur: of this Court was Indebted unto the said Jos: in one thousand five hundred and seventy five pounds of Tob: as by and hereunto annexed may appear and being so thereof Indebted the said Thomas in Consideration thereof the day and year afd at the place afd upon himself did assume and to the said Jos: then and there did faithfully promise that he the said Tho: the said one thousand five hundred and seventy five pd: of Tob: to the said Jos: when he should be hereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and content and altho' the said Tho: one hundred pounds of Tob: percel of the said Debt to the said Joseph he hath paid and Satisfied yet as to the residue thereof being one thousand four hundred
