Dugram late of Somerset County Planter was attalled to answer unto the aforesd M' Cester  
of a plea of trespass upon the case &c And whereupon the said Jos: by  
Lewis Gale his attly complaines that whereas w<sup>t</sup> d<sup>r</sup> Abraham the first day of  
November anno domini one thousand Seven hundred & twenty six at Somerset  
County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Joseph in one  
thousand three hundred & Sixty Nine pd<sup>s</sup> of Tob<sup>b</sup> as by account hereto annexed  
may appear & being so thence of indebtedness the said Abraham in consideration there  
of the day & year aforesaid at his place and upon himselfe did affirme & to the said

thous and three hundred and Sixty Nine pd<sup>s</sup> of Tob<sup>b</sup> to the said Joseph whiche  
should be thence unto requested he would well & faithfully pay & content &  
altho: the said Abraham one hundred & Sixty pd<sup>s</sup> of Tob<sup>b</sup> of the sd debt  
to the said Joseph he hath paid & satisfied yett as to w<sup>t</sup> residue thereof being  
One thousand two hundred & Nine pd<sup>s</sup> of Tob<sup>b</sup> w<sup>t</sup> d<sup>r</sup> Abraham his promise  
exemption aforesaid in forme aforesaid made nothing regarding bidg letting &
