Joseph McClester Late Sheriff

A Copy of the foregoing debts & ac^t were made & sent to be served on the afd Isaac Noble with the writ in the plea afd &c

At which said third Tuesday of March next with the twenty first day of the same Month am^t found one thousand seven hundred & twenty six being the day of the return of the said writ the afd Joseph McClester by his atty afd and the sher of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed likewise Cometh & Maketh return thereof to the Court here endorsed in these words vizt

And the afd Isaac Noble by Geo. Dashiell his atty Comers & Defends the force and injury when & where and saith he cannot deny the action afd nor but that he did upon himselfe a ssume in manner and form as if afd Joseph McClester above against him supposed nor can he deny but if the afd Joseph hath sustained Damages by occasion of the non per formance of his promise & assumption afd to give hundred & fifteen pounds of Tob^o and the same Declaration before & expressly Confessed &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Court that the afd Joseph McClester recover against the afd Isaac Noble as well the sum of five hundred & fifteen pounds of Tob^o his Damages, in forme afd Confessed as also the sum of two hundred & seventy seven pounds of Tob^o for his Costs and charges by him about his Suite in that part Regarded for same Joseph by the Court here of his afd and the afd Debt in Mercy &c

The same Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should Take Peter Peter Henry - Sheriff late of Somerset County prisoner if he should be found in his Bailwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at ^{the third Tuesday of March} ~~dividing~~ ^{the third Tuesday of March} next to answer unto Jov. McClester in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c and that there of he should not fail &c

And the afd Jov. McClester by Levin Gale his attorney proceeded against the afd Peter Henry in the plea afd as followeth vizt
