

Mark Court - - - 1726 - - - 230  
 Hereupon or tender his Body to the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that  
 he the said John Caldwell will do it for him &c

Whereupon the said Peter Greney in his own proper person comes and defends the force  
 and Injury when he - and saith that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid, nor but that he did upon  
 himself a promise in manner aforesaid as the said Joseph Mester above against him supposed  
 neither can he say but that the said Joseph hath sustained damage by occasion of the Non per-  
 formance of his promise and assumption aforesaid to Eight hundred and twenty eight pounds of tobo  
 and the same declaration before in all the words Expressly Confesseth &c

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Joseph Mester recover  
 against the said Peter Greney as well the sum of Eight hundred and twenty eight pounds of tobo  
 & damages aforesaid by him in his declaration aforesaid above supposed as also the sum of three  
 313 hundred & thirty - - - pounds of tobo for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit  
 in that part expended, to the same Joseph by the Court here of his aforesaid adjudged and aforesaid  
 doeth in merrit &c

The same Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take  
 Giles Bashaw late of Somerset County Glauce if he should be found  
 in his Bailiwick & him should safe keep so that he might have  
 his Body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Sou-  
 seth to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next  
 to answer unto Joseph Mester of a plea of Trespass upon the Case &c that  
 there of he should not fail &c And the said Joseph Mester by Levin Gale his  
 attly proceeded against the said Giles Bashaw in the plea aforesaid & followeth the  
 said Giles Bashaw late of Somerset County Glauce was attached to answer  
 unto Joseph Mester of a plea of Trespass upon the Case &c

And where upon the said Joseph by Levin Gale his attly complains & sheweth as follows  
 Giles the first day of Novemb: Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred & twenty six  
 at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Joseph in  
 Six hundred and two pounds of Tobo: as by aut: here unto annexed may in Court appear  
 & being so there of indebted the said Giles in consideration thereof the day & year aforesaid  
 place aforesaid upon himself did assume & to the said Joseph then & there did faithfully  
 promise that he the said Giles would pay & satisfy the said Six hundred & two pounds of Tobo: to the said Joseph  
 when he should be there unto requested he would well & faithfully pay & content  
 Nevertheless the said Giles tho: often requested the said Six hundred & two pounds of  
 Tobo: to the said Joseph hath not paid but the same to him hitherto to pay hath

refused & still doth refuse & deny to the Damage of the said Joseph of one thousand  
 two hundred & four pounds of Tobo: & there of he brings suite &c Levin Gale & Levin Gale & Levin Gale
