Judgment in the place of against the said John Blulligr that then the said John Blulligr shall be thereto bound that then he the said John Blulligr shall pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his Body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said Thos. Gordon will do it for him &c —

Whereupon the said John Blulligr in his own proper person cometh and defendeth the same and saith that he cannot gainsay the action of no: but that he did upon himself assume in manner and forme as the said Jos: M^r Fletcher above against him suggested neither can he say but that the said Joseph hath sustained damage by reason of the non performance of his promise and agreement afft to one thousand pounds of lobs. and the same Declaration before in all the words before — Confesseth &c —

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the afft Jos: M^r Fletcher recover against the said John Blulligr as well the sum of one thousand pounds of lobs his damages afft by him in his Declaration afft above supposed as also the sum of three hundred & twenty one — pounds of lobs. for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part extended to the same Joseph by the Court here of his afft adjudged and the afft Deft in mercy &c —

By the same command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take John Williams late of Somerset County Planter if he should be found in his County and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Wednesday of November then next to answer unto Jos: M^r Fletcher of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and that therefore he should not fail &c — And the said Joseph Fletcher by Lewis Gale his attorney proceeded against the said John Williams in the Plea afft as followeth viz —

John Williams late of Somerset County planter was attached to — Answer unto Joseph Fletcher of trespass upon the case &c — And whereupon the said Joseph by Lewis Gale his attorney complained that whereas the said John the first day of November anno domini one thousand seven hundred & twenty six at Somerset County afft within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Joseph in fourteen hundred forty six pounds of lobs: as by act hereunto annexed may in Court appear and being so thereof indebted the said John in Consideration thereof the day & year afft at the place afft upon himself did asswore & to the said Joseph then & there did faithfully
