And the said John Williams being present herein Court is at the prayer of the plaintiffs atty adjudged to give special bail to the action afo thereupon a certain Richard Beathard of Somerset County Clanker present herein Court undertakes for the said John Williams that if in face the said Joseph Maclester shall recover Judgment in the plea afo against the said John Williams or that the said John Williams shall be therein found that then he the said John Williams shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body <sup>into the</sup> to the Sherr of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said Richard Beathard will do it for him

Whereupon the said John Williams in his own proper person came and defend the force and injury when he said that he can not give say the action afo, nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Joseph Maclester above against
