Therefore it is Considered that the said Jos: M<sup>rs</sup>ter Recover of the said  
John Williams as well the Sum of one thousand four hundred and forty six pounds  
of tobacco his Damages aforesaid by him in his declaration above supposed as also the sum of  
313 three hundred and fifteen — pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about  
his Suit <sup>in that part</sup> expended to the said Joseph by the Court here of his aforesaid adjudged and  
the said Debt in money &c

Elly. The Same Command was given to the Sheriff of Somersett that he should take Mary Hall  
Mary Hall <sup>of</sup> Somersett County widow if she should be found in his Bailly with and  
her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justice of

hundred and forty pounds of tobacco as by aforesaid hereunto annexed may in Court appear and being  
so thereof indebted the said Mary in Consideration thereof of day and Year aforesaid at the place  
aforesaid upon herself did assume and to the said Jos: then and there did faithfully promise  
that she the said Mary the said four hundred and forty pounds of tobacco to the said Jos: when she  
should be hereunto requested she would well and faithfully pay and Content Never  
theless the said Mary her promise and assumption aforesaid in forme aforesaid made nothing regarding  
but blotting and fraudulently subverting the said Jos: in that part faithfully and Sincerely to  
Doeve and Defraud the other thereto requested the said four hundred and forty <sup>of</sup> tobacco
