And the said Edward Boynter being present here in Court is at y<sup>r</sup> prayer of the Clfs attly aff<sup>t</sup> adjudged to give speciall Bayfe to y<sup>r</sup> action of thereupon a certain John Dennis Sen<sup>t</sup>. late of Somdett County Planter present herein Court undertakes for the said Edward Boynter w<sup>t</sup>th case w<sup>t</sup>th J<sup>s</sup> Mc<sup>t</sup>ester Shall recover Indemnity in y<sup>r</sup> clearey against w<sup>t</sup>th Edward Boynter or y<sup>r</sup> law Said Edward Boynter shall be there in Convict that he h<sup>t</sup>le w<sup>t</sup>th said Edward Boynter Shall pay the Condemnation of the Court therupon or y<sup>r</sup> body to the Body to the Custody of the Sher<sup>t</sup> of Somdett County in Satisfaction thereof or w<sup>t</sup>th he said John Dennis Sen<sup>t</sup>. will do it for him &c.

Whereupon w<sup>t</sup>th Edward Boynter in his own proper person comes & defend the same and injury when &c and saith y<sup>r</sup> he Comotgain say y<sup>r</sup> action aff<sup>t</sup> nor but that he did aff<sup>t</sup> upon himselfe in Manner & forme as w<sup>t</sup>th J<sup>s</sup> Mc<sup>t</sup>ester above against him hath Complained nor can he say but that y<sup>r</sup> aff<sup>t</sup> Joseph Mc<sup>t</sup>ester hath Sustained damage by occasion of y<sup>r</sup> non performance of his promise & assumption aff<sup>t</sup> to thour hundred & Seventy Six pds of Tob<sup>t</sup> & the same Deed: in all the words before exprefly Comfesseth

There fore it is Considered y<sup>r</sup> aff<sup>t</sup> Joseph Mc<sup>t</sup>ester recover against y<sup>r</sup> Edward Boynter as well y<sup>r</sup> sum of Four hundred & Seventy Six pds of Tob<sup>t</sup> his damages aff<sup>t</sup> by him in his deet<sup>t</sup> above supposed as also the sum of three hundred and five pounds of Tob<sup>t</sup> for his costs & charges by him about his suite in y<sup>r</sup> part pretended to y<sup>r</sup> same J<sup>s</sup> by the Court here of his absent & judged the aff<sup>t</sup> deet<sup>t</sup> in Mercy &c
