named upon the said day and if there of he should not face & d<sup>r</sup> & the aſt Jor. McGester by Revn.  
Gale his attorney proceeded against Jor. said Wm. Carter in the place aſt aſſolved but

Joseph McGester of a place after named upon the said day &c

And whereupon the said Jor. by Revn. Gale his attorney Complained & wheresoever it did  
w<sup>t</sup> the first day of March Anno domini one thousand and Seven hundred and twenty six at Som-  
erset County within the Jur. of this Court was imdedebted unto Jor. Jor. in one thousand and one  
hundred & fifty three £d. of tolls as by Ind. warrants annexed may appear & being so Imdedebted  
imdedebted he and Wm. in consideration thereof the day & year aſt at J. place and upon his selfe  
did affirme and to the said Jor. then and there did faithfully promise & h<sup>d</sup> to J. Wm. Jor.  
one thousand one hundred & fifty three £d. of tolls to J. Jor. when he should be thereunto  
Reqested he would wee and faithfully pay and content & Altho' J. D<sup>r</sup> Wm. two hundred £d. of tolls  
ponent of J. Debt to J. Jor. he hath paid & satisfied y<sup>t</sup> to J. Residue therof being one  
thousand one hundred and thirty three £d. of tolls J. D<sup>r</sup> Wm. his promise & assumption in  
forma & made nothing regarding but plotting & fraudulently Intending J. D<sup>r</sup> Wm. in t. part  
Crafily & Subtilly to do & defraud J. D<sup>r</sup> one thousand one hundred & thirty £d. of tolls to  
J. Jor. he hath not paid altho' many to do J. D<sup>r</sup> Wm. was often thereto requested but of same  
to him h<sup>d</sup> to pay hee refused & thid doth Refuse & deny to pay to damage of J. D<sup>r</sup> Wm. of  
two thousand two hundred & Sixty Six £d. of tolls & therupon he bringes suit
