John Scarbrough foreman - Thereupon Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said James Duncan if &c to answer &c and now her afterwards to within the fifteenth  
Day of June and if so One thousand seven hundred and twenty five come the said James Duncan in unto  
the Sheriff of Somerset County, and thereupon the said James Duncan being by the Sheriff sent  
to the bar (Indictment read) is Justly demanded how he would acquit himself of the ~~felony~~  
of & saith that of the felony after by the Indictment of, upon him it is charged, he is guilty thereof  
and puts himself in Mercy of the Lord Proprietary -

Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the afo' James Duncan be whipt with twenty  
five lashes on the bare Back were laid on until the blood appear and that he stand in the Pillory  
One quarter of an hour, and that he be taken &c And thereupon as to the corporate punishment of ~~Commanded~~  
is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do thareof immediate Execution according to the Judgment  
ordered by whipping the afo' James Duncan with twenty five lashes on the bare Back were laid on until  
the blood appear at the publick whipping post, and by setting him in the Pillory One quarter of  
an hour, and afterward in the same Court the Sheriff Returns that he hath done the Execution of the  
Judg'mt afo' as to the corporate punishment after he was commanded &c and also it is considered that the  
afo' James Duncan pay unto Thomas Earl the Earle his right & full value of the tobacco <sup>lost</sup> stolen  
which amounts to One hundred & Sixty pounds of tobacco - Wherefore it is Ordered that the  
said James Duncan return home to his Master John Scott's Service, and that the said Scott return  
him to the County Court or Sheriff of the County at the Execution of his Servitude to remuneration to the  
County what tobacco has accrued by reason of the present suit -
