 Mary his wife by their attorney ad and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the  
 foregoing writt was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh Return thereof to the Court  
 here Endorsed in these words Following vid. vide known from ~~all~~ ~~the~~ ~~field~~  
 And the sd. Eric Collins altho' so warned, being solemnly called Cometh not  
 but makes Default &c

Therefore it is Considered that the sd. James Martin and Mary his wife  
 &c. as sd. have their Execution against the sd. Eric Collins of three thousand five  
 hundred and twenty six pounds of lb. three hundred and thirty two pd. of shillings ten  
 and six pence ~~and six pence~~  
 and three hundred and sixty two pounds of lb. their Debt and Damages  
 sd. and that the sd. James and Mary according to the forme of the Statute in such case  
 lately made and provided Recover against the sd. Eric Collins three hundred and sixty  
 three pounds of lb. for their Costs Charges and Damages sustained by reason of delay  
 of Execution of the Debt and Damages ad &c
