the twenty first day of the same month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred &  
twent<sup>y</sup> six being the day of the return of the said W<sup>t</sup> Wit<sup>t</sup> Wit<sup>t</sup>ch the ab<sup>d</sup> James Martin &  
Mary his wife by their attorney ad and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the  
foregoing writ was directed Likewise a Comette and witness return thereof to the Court  
here endorsed in these words Following bid made Known from the Sheriff there  
And the ab<sup>d</sup> Lene Collins altho' so warned, being solemnly called Comette and  
but makes Default &c.
