Jacob Waggoner Somerset Thomas Barker late of Somerset County planter afo^d D^r d^r Thomas
Barker of Somerset was summoned to answer unto Jacob Waggoner of afo^d
D^r Thomas Barker - } that he render unto him six pounds Three Shillings and six pence in current twenty
pence of tobacco which to him he owes and from him the injury done to him &c
And whereupon the afo^d Jacob by Lewis Gale his attorney saith that whereas D^r d^r Thomas afo^d
Eleventh day of June anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred Twenty five at Soudell County
within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing Obligatory Confessed his afo^d
Bonds unto the afo^d Jacob in d^r Six pd^s Three Shillings & Six pence in current twenty pence
of tobacco to be paid unto the afo^d Jacob when thereof he should be required notwithstanding the afo^d
Thomas altho' often required the afo^d Six pd^s Three Shillings & Six pence to the afo^d Jacob hath
not yet rendered but the same to him hereto to render demands and yet doth deny wherein
you say that he is deteriorated and hath damage to the value of twelve pd^s and thereof
being sume & offers here in Court the writing obligatory afo^d which afo^d debt afo^d in form afo^d doth
confess whose date is the same day and year aforesaid

And the afo^d Thomas Barker by George Dashiell his attorney comes and defendeth the same and
Injury wherein & and pray leave to imparle here unto until the next Court and he hath it and
the same day is given to the afo^d Court here also

At which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of March and D^r dom One thousand Seven hundred
and twenty six came againe as well the afo^d Jacob Waggoner as the afo^d Thomas Barker by their
attorneys afo^d and the afo^d Thomas by his said attorney say that he cannot pay the afo^d afo^d off
the afo^d Jacob, nor but that he owe the afo^d Six pounds ^{Three Shillings & Six pence} to the afo^d Jacob in manner and form as the
afo^d Jacob against him hath complained

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the afo^d Jacob Waggoner recover against
the afo^d Thomas Barker Six pounds Three Shillings and Six pence his debt afo^d or also six hundred
and Ninety One - - - pounds off tobacco for his costs and damages to the same Jacob by
the Court here of his afo^d point adjudged and the afo^d deft in mercy & memorandum the afo^d Clerk shall
the penalty Reserving the paying all debt and interest unless paid
