And whereupon the said Jacob by Severin Gale his atty saith that whereas J. d. Thomas Baker the day of June anno Dom one thousand Seven hundred Twenty five at Southwell County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing Obligatory Confessed himselfe Bound unto the said Jacob in J. d. six J. d. three Shillings & six pence in Corn at twenty pence of Bushell to be paid unto J. d. Jacob when thereof he should be required Nevertheless J. d. Thomas altho' often required the said six J. d. three Shillings and six pence to J. d. Jacob hath not yet rendered but the same to him hitherto to tender damage and yet doth deny whereas you he say that he is deteriorated and hath damage to the value of twelve J. d. and thereof bring Suite & offers here in Court the writing obligatory of which is debt and in form and doth therin whose date is the same day and year above said

And the said Thomas Baker by George Darlowe his attorney comes and defends the force and injury whereof and pray leave to dispute here unto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Court here also

At which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of March anno Dom one thousand Seven hundred and twenty six came againe as was the said Jacob Waggoner as the said Thomas Baker by their attorneys and the said Thomas by his said attorney say that he cannot gainay the action of the said Jacob, nor but that he owes the said six pounds three Shillings & six pence to the said Jacob in manner and form as the said Jacob against him hath complained

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the said Jacob Waggoner recover against the said Thomas Baker six pounds three Shillings and Six pence his debt and also six hundred and thirty one pounds of tobacco for his loss and Damages to the same Jacob by the Court here of his own adjudged and the said debt in mercy &c memorand<sup>m</sup> the said debt shall be generally Reserving the paying all debt and Interest until paym<sup>t</sup> &c
