At which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of March anno d^r One thousand Seven hundred and twenty six came again as were the afo Joseph M'Glester by his attorney afo as the afo Isaac Brittingham in his own proper person and he said to Isaac nothing in bar or avoidance of the action afo by which the same party Remained ag^t the afo debt hereof undefended w^m — Wherefore the afo Joseph M'Glester his damage by reason of the non performance of the promise and agreement afo against the afo Isaac Brittingham ought to recover w^m whereupon at the prayer of the afo Joseph and by the consent of the afo Isaac the Justices here according to act of Assembly in full case made and provided did after the damages of the said Joseph by reason of the non performance of the promise and agreement afo beyond his fees and charges by him about his suit in that part Exceeded to twelve hundred and forty eight pounds of tobacco

Therefore it is considered that the afo Joseph M'Glester Recover against the afo Isaac Brittingham twelve hundred and forty eight pounds of tobacco his damages afo by the Justices afo in sum afo Exceeded as also Two hundred and seventy three pounds of tobacco for his fees and charges by him about his suit in that part Exceeded to the same Joseph by the sum hereof his afo agent adjudged and the afo Clerk in Mercy g^r
