

Somerset sh: Whereas a certain John Davis of Somerset County Gent petitioned this Court to turn the Road from the head of John's new Creek to the head of Stephen Horses Creek: which was by the same Court granted so far that the said John Davis, make and bear a new Road as aforesaid as good and as near as the Old Road and its further Ordered that Thomas Williams and Thomas Dixon both of Somerset County Gent view the same new Road, by the aid of John Davis to be cleared, and to see if the same be as near good, and passable, as the Old Road, and to make their Report to March Court next ~~due~~ by order of Novemb. Court and ~~order~~. 1726

On the back side of the foregoing it was thus Endorsed --- viz

March 22: 1726-7. May it please your worships Gentlemen we have viewed the Road according to order and find it cleared and as well and as dry as the other and we do believe that the within mentioned Road is as convenient to the Inhabitants as without our hands

Dasher &c
