Town and they having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Littleton Town and pay unto Andrew Collins Sixty pounds of tobacco
being due unto him for his attendance two days as Evidence on behalf of the said Littleton Town
and against Rowland Bewis and Mary his wife he having made oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Littleton Town and pay unto Solomon Toward and James
Bates Ninety pounds of tobacco each for their attendance three days each as Evidence on behalf
of the said Littleton Town and against Rowland Bewis and Mary his wife they having
made oath to the same &c
