The s^d Thomas and Sarah have Sustained by Omission of the premises a^d - We command you that by the Oath of honest and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick or County you diligently Enquire what Damages the s^d Thomas and Sarah have Sustained as well by Omission of the premises a^d, as for their Costs and Charges by them about their Suite in that Part Expended, and that Inquisition which thereupon you shall take make you make known to Our Justices of Our County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of June next under your Seal, and the Seal of those by whose Oath you make the same Inquisition and have you then and there the Names of those by whose Oath you shall make that Inquisition and this writ Witness our own Hand Chief Justice of Our said Court the 20th day of March in the Ninth Year of Our Dominion and Dom^o 1724 - Thomas Hayward Cl^{er}

All which said third Tuesday of June to wit the fifteenth day of the same month and Dom^o One thousand Seven hundred & twenty five being the day of the return of the said Writ came as well the s^d Oath as the s^d Oath by their attorneys and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed likewise came and made return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following vid^l - The Execution
